Richmond Hill Mobility Foundation (RH Mobility) would like to give your community information on a By-Law that was created, and is helping to accomplish this for the residents of Richmond Hill.

On December 13th, 2004 the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill presented and passed the Disable Parking Reserve By-Law (By-Law No. 258-04) see attached.

Through the reserve RH Mobility has invested funds from the reserve to help fund such things as accessible parks and playgrounds, purchasing fitness equipment for community fitness centers and any other mobility initiatives within the community. Individuals and organizations, within the Town of Richmond Hill, can also apply for funding by submitting an application to the Town of Richmond Hill for disbursement of funds from the Disabled Parking Reserve. BY-LAW

The Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill By-Law No. 258-04

A By-Law to establish a Disabled Parking Reserve

WHEREAS Section 163 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, authorizes Council to establish reserve for any purpose for which the municipality has authority to expend funds;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of The Town of Richmond Hill desires to segregate a portion of the proceeds of fines collected from disabled parking offenses for the purpose of funding future mobility initiatives in the Town;

AND WHEREAS Council at its meeting of December 13, 2004 adopted the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole at its meeting of December 6, 2004 in SRFIN.04.098 to establish a Reserve for Disabled Parking Revenue;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. A reserve to be known as the Disabled Parking Reserve is hereby established.
2. The Disabled Parking Reserve shall be funded from the allocation of a portion of the proceeds of fines collected from disabled parking offenses.
3. The Disabled Parking Reserve shall be used for the following purposes;
 - a. to fund mobility initiatives in the Town as approved by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill hereinafter called "The Corporation";
 - b. such other purposes as may be approved by the Council of The Corporation.
4. This By-law is deemed to come into force on the 13th day of December, 2004.
